There is room for electric wipers and/or air conditioning! All radios have RCA inputs for CD, MP3 Player or Satellite options. Subtly printed in the dial background is the FM dial scale. Inside the case is our proven digital tuner system with a 180 watt RMS power amplifier! Two powerful microprocessors monitor the "human interface" (knobs & pushbuttons) and, through the magic of software, make the radio dial imitate the original while pumping out a sound that is cleaner and much more powerful than the best radio that was available when your truck was new! Radios with push-buttons have 10 presets (5 AM and 5 FM).

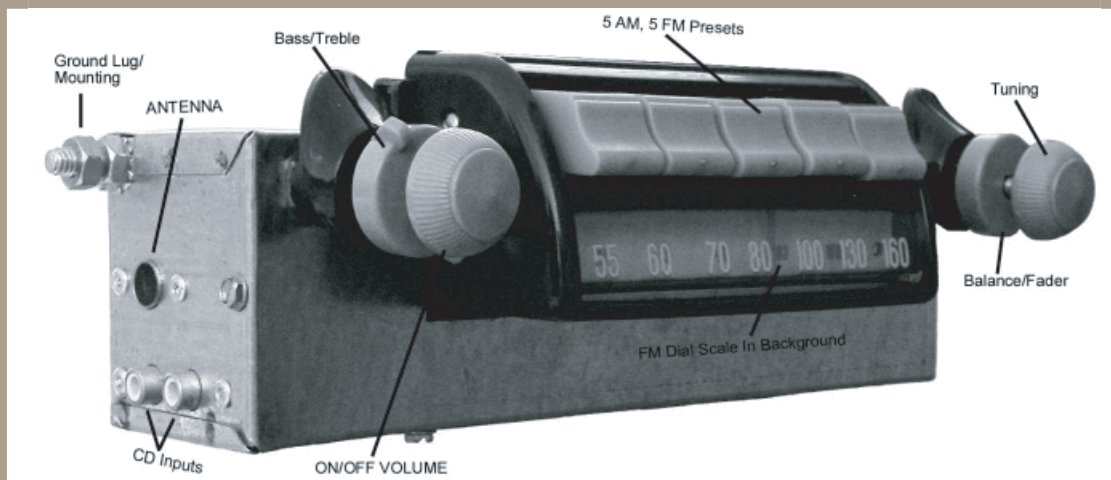

Digitally tuned AM/FM/Stereo front end provides stable, high quality reception. Sensitivity (FM S/N 30dB) typ 5dBu, (AM S/N 20dB) typ 29dBu).

Analog controls look and feel like the original radio.

All controls easily accessible. Volume, Bass, Treble, Balance, Fader and Tuning from original-looking controls.

1/2" shafts on controls for mounting (same size and thread as original shafts).

4 x 45 watts RMS output allows up to 180 watts of audio power.  
Maximum power = 180 watts RMS (45Watts X 4 Speakers 4 ohm, 14.4v, 1kHz).

AM dial scale in foreground looks original - FM dial scale in background.

11.5 - 16.0 Volt DC Negative ground input only.
